 - 19 responses
 - Results:
 - 18 read it; 1 did not
 - 31.6% agree 10.5% do not agree; 47.4% somewhat agee; 10.5% do not know

6. Updates from Murray for PAC consideration

- Basketball just wrapped up
- Next week: Rugby is starting up (grades 4-5); 14 schools participating
- Assemblies starting up again; Murray will be sending details on what this will look like
 - Tuesday/Wednesday next week assembly practices
- Friday 22 April 2022 class photos plus full assembly to listen to jazz bands
- Impacts of SD 61 on SJD programs
 - No more Grade 5 strings program
 - School timing changing for 2022/2023 school year;
 - o standardized day across the district to continue
 - o 45 minute long break; looking at alternatives for younger kids to break it up
 - District will be surveying parents on start and end times; day can't be longer but the range can shift slightly
 - Supervision available from 8:25 am onwards at front of school only
- School supplies → will be organized by the school again; parents pay a flat fee
 - Collected \$12k; approximately \$4k remaining
 - Murray will push outstanding money to PAC for next years budget
